Thank you for choosing one of our products. We hope that you enjoy the building process.

Read the instructions and follow the directions. For any query or problem which may come up, you can contact DOMUS KITS<sup>®</sup>, S.L.

Cut the figures from the cardboard patterns along the perimeter. Fold the figures along the dotted line using a cutter and a ruler to mark the edges. Glue the flanges marked on the patterns to the reserved area on the wooden base. Then, join them with the others to form the cardboard structure.

Use the glue provided (white glue for wood) to attach the ceramic parts between the line outside the perimeter and the cardboard structure, beginning at an angle of the structure. Keep clear of the lines for the doors and windows, as well as the lined areas. To build the walls, attach the ceramic parts spontaneously, with no prior selection by size (either large or small can be used, as long as the rows are the same height). The parts can be adapted to one another with sandpaper so that they occupy the necessary space or position.

Use the thinnest pieces for the chimney and glue them flat on the cardboard.

During the entire process it is suggested that you follow the photographic sequence provided as an example.

Adjust the height of the final row of rocks on the wall with fine sandpaper based on the slope of the back roof.

After the house has been built, install the boards for the roofs on the edges of the walls. The parts for the roof can be glued on the edges after verifying the number of rows and how much they must overlap with one another (the minimum possible). Use sandpaper to adjust the parts which occupy crucial positions, vertexes or angles.

Glue the strips in the form of crossbeams, cut to measure based on the indications on the cardboard. Paint the middle wall areas with glue and cover them with a thin layer of white marble powder (supplied), as though it were a coating.

Cut the bundle of esparto grass into strips. Bunch them together and dampen them with water and glue. Stick them to the roof as shown in the photo.

Build the wheel of the waterwheel on the pattern: cut, display and glue the different pieces of wood for each side of the waterwheel. Join both faces to the cylindrical piece of the main shaft, using the blades of the waterwheel (of the same length as the shaft). Place the wheel in the appropriate place, as shown in the photograph (between the wall of the house and a small wall for the water channel).

Cut the wooden strips to measure to cover the appropriate cardboard areas of the doors and windows.

Finally, cover the wooden board with white glue and sprinkle green "flock" on it until it is attached. Decorate the floor or even the walls of the house and the surrounding walls with moss. This decorative part of the assembly is important since it gives the model a finished appearance. Therefore, we encourage you to decorate according to your preferences.
